

AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY

- To spread, promote, and provide knowledge and training in the discipline of Physical Education throughout the country and to develop a strong sports culture among today's youth.
- To work in partnership with different State, National, and International Associations/Federations for conducting and organizing various sports events and activities.
- To create and provide a platform for trainers and trainees to represent and promote the sport at National as well as International levels.
- To provide scholarships to deserving and economically weaker trainees/players of the sport and to create employment opportunities for trainers and coaches.
- To educate the public at large regarding women's rights and the means of enforcing such rights for achieving equality, development, and peace, and to work towards the empowerment of women.
- To educate women across the country about sports and self-defense, thereby encouraging women's safety, confidence, and empowerment.
- To establish, support, run, and provide grants or financial assistance to institutions such as:
 - Matsogi-Do Institute of Martial Art
 - Matsogi-Do India
 - Matsogi-Do Tournament Committee
 - Matsogi-Do Education Institutions

The Governing Body shall have the authority to change the name of any Committee/Institution/College through mutual decision.

The Society may also establish and support Colleges, Physical Education Colleges, Libraries, Reading Rooms, Health & Physical Education Laboratories, Research Centers, and other institutions of similar nature in India for the development and advancement of education and the diffusion of knowledge among the public.

The Society may also provide employment consultancy and assistance for employment opportunities in India and abroad.

- To establish, maintain, and run studentships, scholarships, and other forms of aid for students, including the supply of Physical Education books, stipends, medals, and incentives, without discrimination on the basis of caste, color, race, creed, or sex, with special priority to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Minorities, and economically weaker sections.
- To promote, establish, support, maintain, and grant aid to institutions working for the promotion of Science, Literature, Music, Films, Drama, Fine Arts, preservation of Historical Monuments, and Research Institutions in India having similar objectives for the benefit of the general public under the name of Matsogi-Do.
- To establish, maintain, or grant aid for Parks, Gardens, Sports Clubs, Self-Defense Art Centers, Matsogi-Do Martial Art Clubs, Yoga Classes, Musafirkhanas, Dharamshalas, Rest Houses, Gaushalas, and other facilities for public utility.
- To grant aid and render assistance to other public charitable activities and institutions.
- To work in the fields of Consumer Awareness, Road Safety, Non-Conventional Energy, Human Rights, Women's Rights, and other social welfare activities.
- To establish and develop institutions for physically challenged and mentally disabled persons and to provide them with education, food, clothing, medical support, and other necessary assistance.
- To undertake any other objective that may be added by the unanimous decision of the Governing Body through a Resolution passed in two successive meetings of the Board Members.
